



Nigeria60 Data and Privacy Policy

The university's International Office is working in partnership with Big Ideas' Nigeria60 programme to research and share 60 alumni stories celebrating the strong connections between the University and Nigerian and Nigerian-diaspora students as part of the Universities exciting new Africa Group initiative.

Both organisations are committed to protecting the privacy and security of your personal information. This privacy notice describes how we collect and use personal information about you during and after your relationship with us, in accordance with data protection law.

What we will collect

We will only collect data from you that is necessary for you to participate in the project. Big Ideas and Coventry University will act as joint Data Controllers and will collect the following data

- Your Email address
- Your first and second names
- Information regarding your university degree with Coventry University
- Information about your work after graduation
- A 'selfie' image (to be requested for a celebratory montage of Coventry University's Nigerian / Nigeria-diaspora alumni)

Data Usage

The Big Ideas and Coventry University are independent 'data controllers' of the information you provide. This means that we both decide what your personal information is used for, and the ways in which it is processed by us separately. The legal basis on which the Coventry University processes your personal information is Coventry University's legitimate interest in contacting the university's Nigerian students and alumni as part of the CU Africa Group. The legal basis on which Big Ideas processes your personal information is legitimate interest in managing the acquisition of participants for the same project.

The Coventry University and Big Ideas have each balanced our individual set of interests in processing your data for this event against any impact on your individual rights and freedoms. Coventry University and Big Ideas have each found that such impact does not override our respective interests.



Big Ideas will use online platforms provided by Survey Monkey, Eventbrite, Mailchimp and/or Google to gather your data, invite you to events and keep you informed.

Personal data collected will be shared between Big Ideas, whose Privacy Policy is available via the [Big Ideas Policies page](#) and Coventry University, whose [data protection and privacy policies](#) are available on their website. Coventry University and Big ideas will not share your data with anyone else, and will only use the data that we collect for the purposes specified in this Privacy Notice.

Big Ideas may request you to submit an image of yourself to be used for promotional purposes. You will be asked at the time of the request to agree to your image being used for specific promotional purposes, and will at the time of the request be given the option to 'opt-out' of submitting/given the chance to withdraw your likeness at any point.

Storing and Deleting your Data

The data you have provided will be kept by Coventry University for use in the future. Coventry University will retain your data for their archives.

Big Ideas will securely store images and data from participants whose story is spotlighted in the project celebration for two years after the programme ends. After this time, the images will be deleted.

Any virtual recordings of events that make up part of the Nigeria60 programme, including edited promotion videos and imagery will be kept in perpetuity as part of Coventry University's and Big Ideas' archives.
